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## Exclusion Procedure for Illness/ Communicable Disease

### Minimum Period of Exclusion from Childcare Settings

Disease/ Illness	Minimal Exclusion Period
<b>Antibiotics prescribed</b>	48 hours of medication before return
<b>Temperature</b>	If sent home ill, child must be off for 24 hours
<b>Vomiting</b>	Child must stay at home during illness and must remain home for a period of 48 hours <u>after</u> the last bout of vomiting
<b>Conjunctivitis</b>	Seek doctor's advice. Child must remain home until eye's are clear
<b>Diarrhoea</b>	Child must stay at home during illness and must remain home for a period of 48 hours <u>after</u> the last bout of diarrhoea
<b>Chickenpox</b>	Child must stay at home until all spots have scabbed and no new spots are appearing.
<b>Gastro-enteritis, food poisoning, salmonellosis and dysentery</b>	Until authorised by District Community Physician
<b>Infective hepatitis</b>	7 days from onset of jaundice
<b>Measles</b>	7 days from appearance of the rash
<b>Meningococcal infection</b>	Until authorised by District Community Paediatrician. Inform Ofsted
<b>Mumps</b>	Until the swelling has subsided and in no case less than 7 days from onset of illness
<b>Petussis (whooping cough)</b>	21 days from the onset of paroxysmal cough
<b>Poliomyelitis</b>	Until declared free from infection by District Community Physician
<b>Scarlet fever and streptococcal infection of the throat</b>	Until appropriate medial treatment has been given and in no case for less than 3 days from the start of treatment
<b>Tuberculosis</b>	Until declared free from infection by District Community Physician
<b>Typhoid fever</b>	Until declared free from infection by District Community Physician
<b>Impetigo</b>	Until lesion are crusted or healed
<b>Pediculosis (lice)</b>	Until appropriate treatment has been given
<b>Plantar warts</b>	No exclusion. Should be treated and covered
<b>Ringworm</b>	Seek medical advice and treatment
<b>Scabies</b>	Need not to be excluded once appropriate treatment has been given
